The Objective

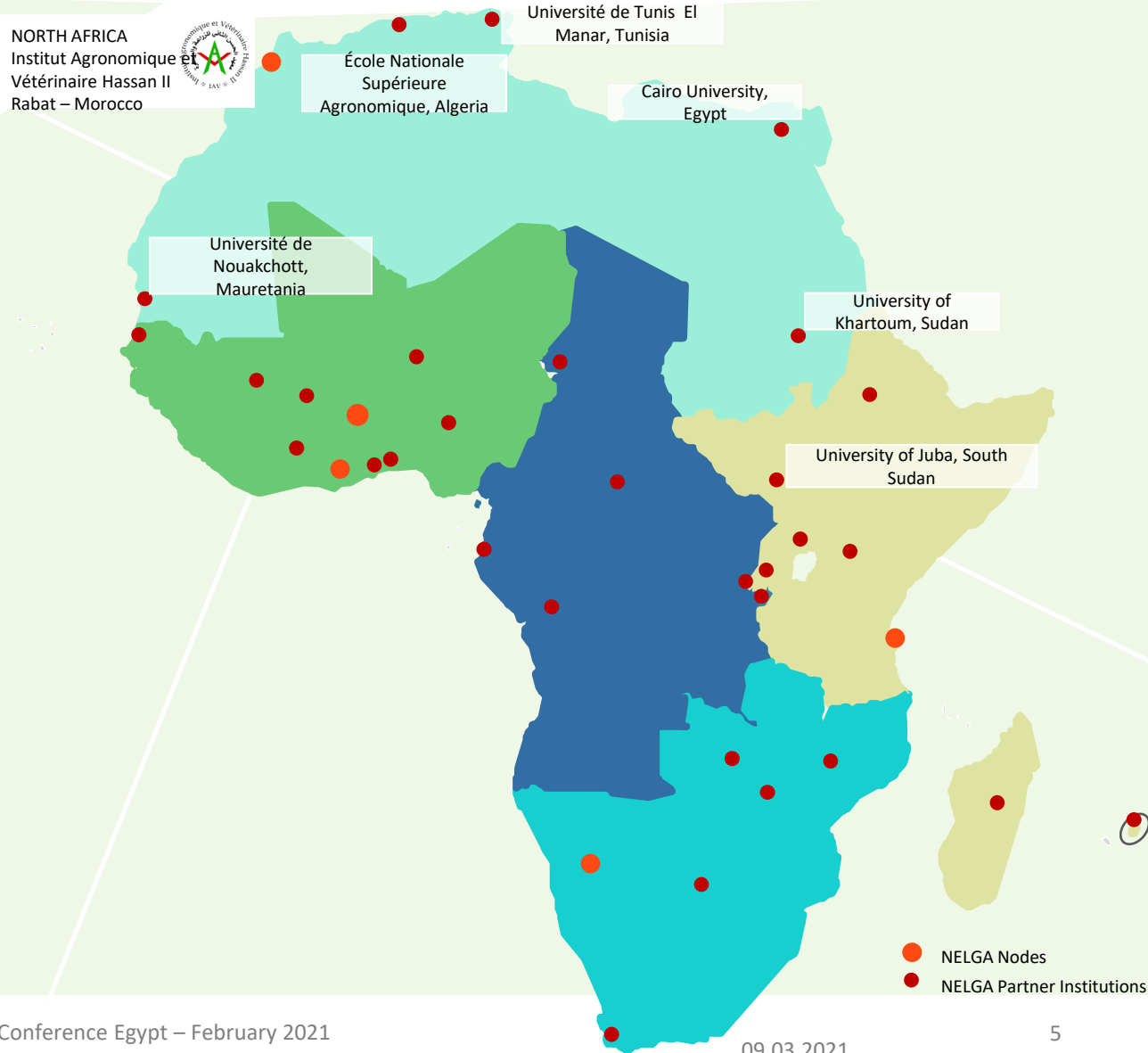
1. To review the current land tenure conditions in the region.
2. To support demand driven research that meet training and research needs of different LG stakeholder.
3. To identify the common challenges of the region.
4. To inform tailored capacity development in meeting the common challenges as identified in the research



In a way to **accompany LG reforms in North Africa and allow NELGA North Africa :**

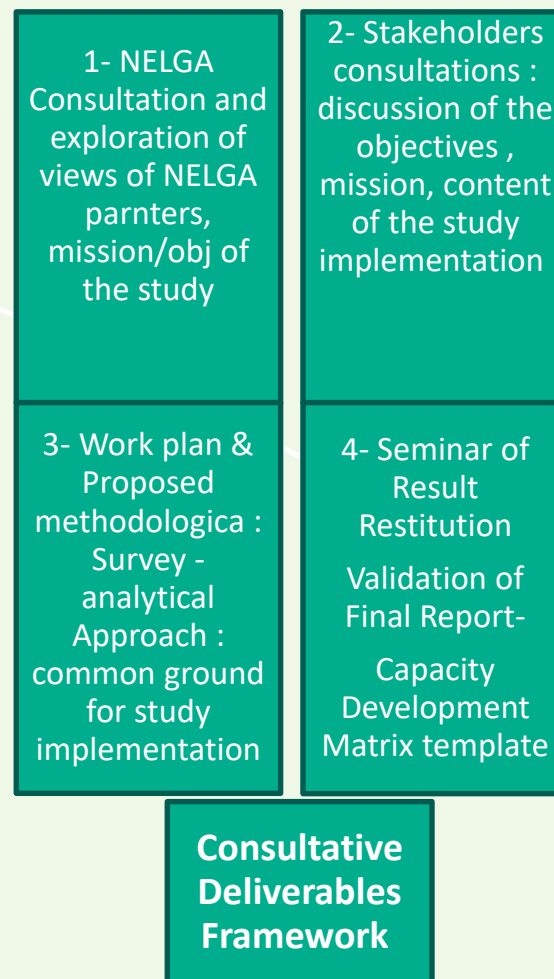
- **- to implement a regional capacity development programme in LG; and support LG dialogue, create linkages, monitor land policy development in the region**

Methodology & Consultative Deliverables Framework :

- ❑ The ToRs were revised and validated by NELGA NA in collaboration with SLGA in June- July 2018
- ❑ The partners were informed of the study by the Project's coordinator. Information was also communicated by the IC in collaboration with NELGA coordinator + SLGA NA
- ❑ The International consultant was recruited in September 2018
- ❑ The idea was to steer the collaborative work to the achievement of the general objectives and outcomes of the scoping study
Timeline : August - December 2019

Methodology Scope

- Interdisciplinary + Evidence based
- Urban and rural, local/national, govt/private
- Raised the issue of access to civil society, vulnerable groups, equity, HR, youth
- Defragmentation of LG issues to reduce complexity
- Highlight the issue of equity, HR, youth and gender disaggregated data

Research Questions

- Who are the land stakeholders of each NELGA partner ?
- What are the strengths or capacity gaps ?
- What are the results of SWOT analysis
- Are there any specific needs and challenges related to gender, HR, youth issues ? Are there any gender disaggregated data ?
